| <p>Examples of existing Types of Markers:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> SAR, DAR or Other Fraternal Organizations Bronze Stakes, Lugs or Flat tablets and In-ground Granite Stones or Flat Tablets. VA: Veterans Administration or other Granite or Marble Upright Stones or Granite or Bronze Flat Tablet <p>A Patriot or Compatriot Grave Marking is defined as a service conducted honoring a Patriot from the American Revolution or a Compatriot with an unveiling of a new grave marker or lug. Granite markers bear the SAR Maltese cross of four arms and eight points, with a center bearing the SAR Minuteman w/stars logo, the year 1775 and the word Patriot or Compatriot. The Bronze Lug or Stake a center bearing the SAR Minuteman w/stars logo and the year 1775. VA and other headstones, upright and flat, should bear the SAR Minuteman w/stars logo, the year 1775 and the letters SAR. At minimum they bear have SAR Minuteman w/stars logo, the year 1775.</p> <p>A Patriot or Compatriot Memorial Service is defined as a service conducted in the same manner as a Patriot Grave Marking but does not involve an unveiling of a new grave marker or lug. It is not considered as a Patriot or Compatriot Grave Marking unless it is not possible to install a grave marker or lug.</p> <p><i>Reference to the placement of markers may be found in the NSSAR "GRAVE MARKING MANUAL VERSION 7" Section 7: pages 6-8.</i></p> | | | | | |
